
The Beehive State's June 2023 unemployment rate increased to 2.4%, and its nonfarm payroll employment increased by 3.2%, or 54,200 jobs, during the last 12-months. Industry sectors leading the job growth were leisure and hospitality (17,000); education and health services (11,200); and government (6,900). By contrast, the only industry sector with negative job growth was financial activities (-700).

UTAH EMPLOYMENT REMAINS STRONG







Annual Growth Rate by County, 2021-2022



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
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UTAH REAL GDP BELOW NATIONAL FIGURE
