
The Beehive State's August 2023 unemployment rate rose to 2.5%, and its nonfarm payroll employment increased by 2.5%, or 41,400 jobs, during the last 12 months. Industry sectors leading the job growth were leisure and hospitality (+16,300); education and health services (+9,400); and government (+8,100). By contrast, the industry sectors with negative job growth were trade, transportation, and utilities (-1,000) and manufacturing (-300).


UTAH EMPLOYMENT REMAINS STRONG



UNEMPLOYMENT VARIES BY COUNTY



Annual Growth Rate by County, 2021-2022




