

U.S. employers added 336,000 jobs last month, far surpassing expectations heading into the monthly jobs report. The Labor Department also revised up estimates from July and August by a net 119,000 jobs. September's national unemployment rate remained unchanged at 3.8%, along with its labor force participation rate at 62.8%.







SMALL BUSINESS OPTIMISM DIPS


September 2023: NFIB Small Business Index = 90.8

MANUFACTURING INDEX INDICATES CONTRACTION


Septepmber 2023: ISM Manufacturing Index = 49.0%

SERVICES INDEX CONTINUES TO INCREASE


September 2023: ISM Services Index = 53.6%


