
# ECONOMIC SNAPSHOT

The Beehive State's unemployment rate rose to 2.6% in September, and its jobs increased by 35,200, or 2.1%, during the last 12 months. Industry sectors leading the job growth were leisure and hospitality (+9,700); government (+8,100); and education and health services (+7,700). By contrast, the industry sectors with negative job growth were trade, transportation, and utilities (-2,000); and manufacturing (-1,000).




# UNEMPLOYMENT VARIES BY COUNTY


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## UTAH GDP GROWTH NEAR NATIONAL AVERAGE
