
The Beehive State's unemployment rate has remained steady at 2.8% for the last seven months, and its total number of jobs increased by 35,600, or 2.1%, during the last 12 months. Industry sectors leading the job growth were government (+12,700); education and health services (+11,800); and construction (+6,600). By contrast, the industry sectors with negative job growth were financial activities (-1,300); and information (-100).




Annual Growth Rate by County, 2022-2023


UTAH GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT GROWTH


